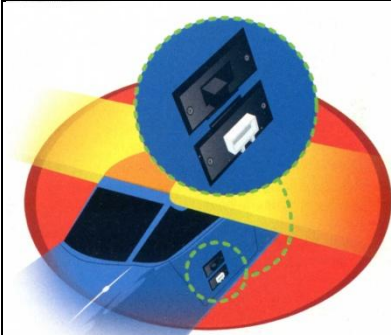

TIP OF THE MONTH

Easy Access to your LIFE or LIPO receiver battery lead

Many people are turning to LiFe & LiPo batteries to power the radio and ignition systems in their aircraft. To properly charge these batteries you must use the balance lead. Many of these batteries are installed in places that are not easily accessible so to solve this problem add a balance lead extension to the batteries balance lead. Take an extra switch plate or fabricate one from plastic sheet or plywood and epoxy the balance lead connector to the plate. Install the plate with the connector in a convenient location, preferably near the power switch and you are ready to easily charge your battery.

Batteries: Lumenier 1300mAh 3s 35c Lipo Battery (XT60 connector) for \$16.99 each at GetFPV.com. RX: OrangeRx R620X 6Ch 2.4 GHz DSM2/DSMX Full Range Receiver w/Sat Diversity Antenna, Failsafe and CPPM. CPPM output is on the bind port plug. CPPM is built into the RX making for a single wire connection from RX to flight controller board.
